1 WORLD CUP RANKING

Special World Cup ranking lists (different from fluent ranking lists generally used to determine seeded couples for World and Continental championships) are established for each year.

Only those categories, that can participate in the SAP World Cup Final, are affected by these ranking lists:

- Rock'n'Roll Juveniles
- Boogie Woogie Juniors
- Rock'n'Roll Juniors
- Rock'n'Roll Main Class Contact Style
- Boogie Woogie Main Class
- Rock'n'Roll Main Class Free Style
- Boogie Woogie Seniors

These World Cup ranking lists are named: **SAP World Cup “year” “category”**
e.g.: SAP World Cup 2019 Rock'n'Roll Main Class Free Style

The World Cup ranking list of each categories is aimed at the selection of the best couples of the year for the SAP World Cup Final.

Each couple in each category adds points based on the results of the World Cup of the year.

All the results of the World Cups of the year except one, the one for which the couple got the lowest number of points, are taken into account in the total of points. If a couple does not participate in a World Cup, then a number of points equal to zero is given to him.

The couples will be ranked in descending order of their total of points, the first being the one that totals the most of points, and the last being the one that totals the least. The points awarded for the World Cup Final will be multiplied by factor two (2) (double points).

These points awarded at the end of the World Cup Final are added to all other points and, together with previous points, used to determine the final placement on the World Cup ranking.

2 SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The couples participating in the SAP World Cup Final will be selected through the World Cup ranking list of the year to each category.

In each category, Top twenty (20) couples on the World Cup ranking list are qualified.

Each nation can announce two (2) additional couples outside the quota of qualified couples. No other additional announcements will be possible.

3 COMPETITION RULES

All categories (Rock'n'Roll and Boogie Woogie) will be carried out in Spider (battle) system after the first round.

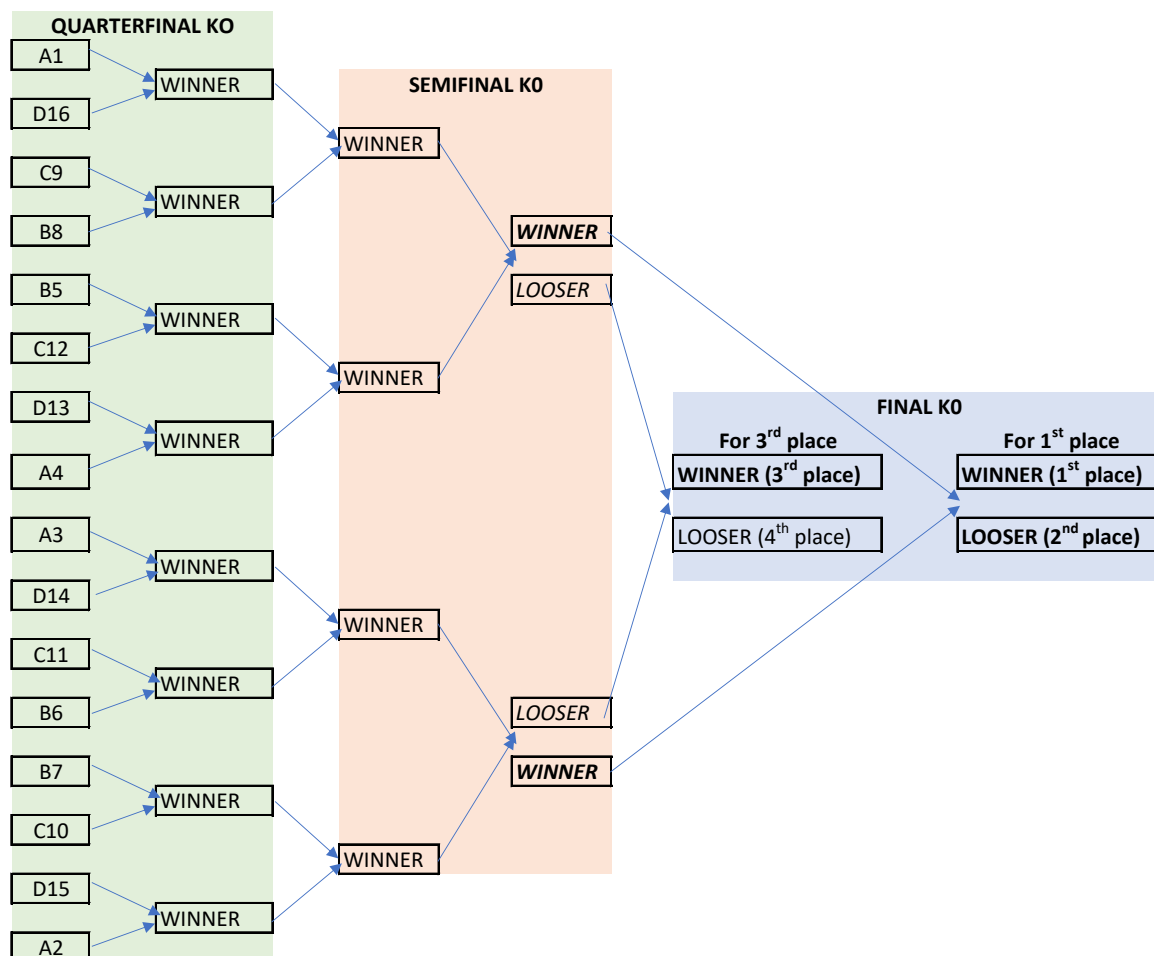
The first round is a ranking round.

The top sixteen (16) couples at the end of the first round will be selected to compete to the spider competition.

Classification after the first round:

Top 16 couples after the 1st Round	
Couple on 1st place	A1

Couple on 4th place	A4
Couple on 5th place	B5

Couple on 8th place	B8
Couple on 9th place	C9

Couple on 12th place	C12
Couple on 13rd place	D13

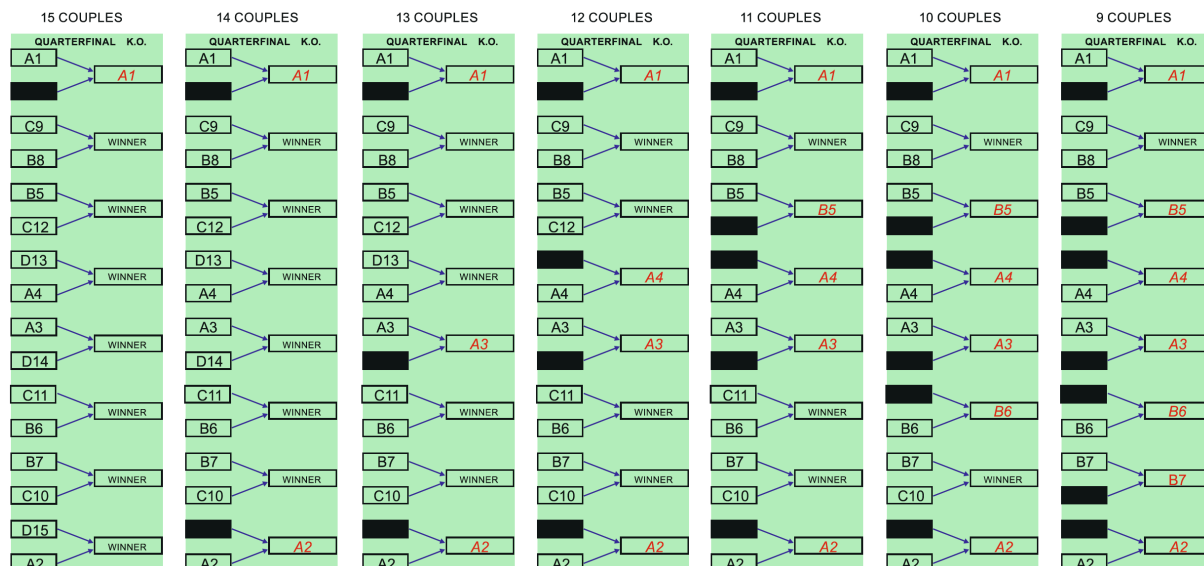
WRRC World Cup Final Spider System:



In case of less than sixteen (16) couples are registered, the ranking round is still danced. After this ranking round, each couple will be placed in the spider board as explained above (see ranking board).

For each battle in which a couple is missing, the other one will automatically be declared the winner and will go to the next round.

e.g.



For Rock'n'Roll Main Class Contact and Free Style:

- 6 acrobatic elements (with appropriate acro limitation) are danced from (and inclusive) the round of four (4) (semifinal and final rounds)
- There is no footwork, even for the final round
- There is no round with own music. The music is randomly chosen by the organizer.

For Boogie Woogie Main and Seniors:

- There is no slow round, even for the final round

Final ranking will be established at the end of the competition as follow:

- 1st place is the winner of the Grand Final (round for 1st place)
- 2nd place is the loser of the Grand Final (round for 1st place)
- 3rd place is the winner of the Small Final (round for 3rd place)
- 4th place is the loser of the Small Final (round for 3rd place)
- From 5th to 8th places are ranked regarding the mark reach in round 8 → 4
- From 9th to 16th places are ranked regarding the mark reach in round 16 → 8
- Couples who not access to spider board are ranked regarding the mark reach in the first round

4 PRIZE MONEY

Prize money (excl. tax) is awarded only for Main Class categories.

Prize Money is paid by WRRRC for the final placement on SAP World Cup Final competition and on World Cup ranking as follow:

- Top four (4) couples on the SAP World Cup Final competition, and
- Top 10 couples on the World Cup ranking list
- The budget for the Prize money will be decided every year by the Presidium following the available financial resources.

All concerned couples are obliged to hand out the official form (one person = one account) during the registration on the World Cup Final.

Official form will be published on the WRRRC homepage before the competition.

At the end of the competition, the amounts will be confirmed and signed by the WRRRC representatives.
